

Invitations Fit for a King and Queen

Invite your guests to an anniversary celebration with a festive invitation.

What you'll need

- Separate small-scale photo of each spouse
- Decorative papers in assorted colors that complement the photos
- Party info printed out by hand or on the computer
- From a deck of cards: the King and Queen of Hearts
- Small heart stickers or die-cut metallic hearts
- Pencil, ruler, and scissors; or ruler, cutting mat, and craft knife
- Rubber cement & tacky glue with fine applicator tip
- Scanner
- Stationery: plain, colored cards with matching or complementary envelopes
- Postage stamps as needed

What to do

- 1 Carefully cut out the inside pictures on the playing cards, leaving the borders intact. (Note: If you do not wish to cut up your playing cards, scan and print them onto photo paper.) Use the inner area as a pattern to cut a same-size rectangle from bright red paper. Draw and cut out an oval slightly smaller than the photos of the couple.
- 2 Using a computer and a script font, type "You're Invited By Royal Decree," and "Anniversary Party Celebration!", adding the number of years the couple has been married. Use a border to surround these two elements of text. Print out on colorful paper.
- 3 Arrange all the elements on a background of bright yellow paper, 4" x 6". Using rubber cement or glue stick, glue each element in place.
- 4 Embellish the collage with heart confetti using tacky glue and heart stickers.
- 5 At a local Fujifilm retail photo center, scan collage and print 4" x 6" photos, however many you need. Glossy photo paper will provide the best results. If printing at home, use Fujifilm photo paper to get outstanding prints with brilliant color.
- 6 Glue each scanned, printed photo on plain cards. Print out and glue essential party information to the inside of each card.
