

# Capture the First Day of School

*Send a special picture card that captures the magic of your child's experience.*

## What you'll need

- 4"x 6" photos, one for each card
- Card-stock colored paper
- Glue stick
- Assorted art supplies for decorating the cards, such as: crayons, markers, colored pencils, stickers, paper scraps, decorative edged scissors, decorative hole punch, trims

## What to do

- 1 For each card, fold heavy-stock colored paper in half and use a glue stick to add a photo. Spread out assorted art supplies and let the new student decorate the card fronts, and dictate messages for the inside. ("Guess what, Grandma? There's another Andrea in my class!"). This project may turn into a whole series of cards that keep the relatives updated.
- 2 As school gets underway, give your child daily reminders of the safe and familiar—personalized school supplies. Slip a cropped photo into an ID tag for a backpack, or cover a pencil box or perhaps the inside lid of a lunchbox with one or more photos, applying a protective layer of clear, self-adhesive vinyl.
