

Here Come the Bride and Groom!

A collage of special photos is the perfect engagement party invitation.



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What you'll need

- Small-scale photos of the bride and groom-to-be
- Decorative papers in assorted colors that complement the photos, plus one in a spectrum of shades
- Party info printed out by hand or on the computer
- Assorted wedding embellishments: bells, rings, etc...
- Tiny star confetti
- Small heart stickers
- Pencil, ruler and scissors, OR ruler, cutting mat and craft knife, for cutting straight edges
- Rubber cement or glue stick, plus tacky glue with a fine applicator tip
- Oversized envelopes

Optional: Card-stock colored paper for backing the scanned design

What to do

- 1 Make a collage: Use a 4" x 6" rectangle of paper in a spectrum of colors as the background. Using rubber cement or glue stick, glue on photos of the bride and groom-to-be, with a plus sign centered on a heart (all cut from contrast paper) between them. Continue the simple equation with two small strips for an equal sign.
- 2 Using a computer and a fun font or two, type "Engagement Party!" and all the party information, in well spaced lines. Pick bright, contrasting colors for the printed text and for the paper. Glue "Engagement Party!" text under the photos and a wedding bells motif alongside it. Glue everything to a background paper, and cut and glue the party information all around the edges.
- 3 Embellish the collage with star confetti using tacky glue. Add heart stickers. Trim collage to 5" x 7".
- 4 At a Fujifilm photo kiosk, scan collage and print as many 5" x 7" photos as needed. Glossy photo paper will provide the best results.
- 5 Send invitation as is, or glue each scanned, printed photo on card stock to back and "frame" the invitation. Use oversized envelopes and check for correct postage.
