

Create an Eerie Monster Marquee

Set the tone for a frighteningly fun night with pictures of memorable monsters!

What you'll need

- 8" x 10" photos of monsters
- Neon poster-board, 14" x 20"
- Metallic silver craft paint
- Silver glitter paint
- Round, foam brush, 1 3/4" wide
- Spray adhesive
- Scissors or craft knife and cutting mat

Optional: clear, self-adhesive vinyl; decorative-edge scissors; glue stick; 18" x 24" foam core board or corrugated plastic yard sign boards; garden stakes, 48" or longer; hammer and carpet tacks; duct tape

What to do

- 1 Select and print 8" x 10" monster photos at your local Fujifilm retail photo center, or print them at home on 8 1/2" x 11" Fujifilm photo paper.
- 2 Trim poster board in neon colors to 14" x 17" and glue a print to the center of each, using spray adhesive or glue stick.
- 3 For marquee lights, add large metallic circles all around the photo. Here, metallic silver craft paint and glitter paint were stamped with a round, foam brush, 1 3/4" wide. Alternatively, use metallic award stickers. Strips of neon paper, cut with a decorative-edge scissors and adhered with glue stick help balance out any spacing irregularities.
- 4 If needed, weatherproof the poster-board with clear, self-adhesive vinyl. Tack finished posters on a fence, tree, side of house, etc. For signs on stakes, glue prints with or without poster-board to corrugated plastic yard boards or foam-core boards, and tack to wood garden stakes. Plant stakes in the ground or lean signs where you want them. Surround with pumpkins, plastic bats or spiders.
