

# A Photo Memory Box Says Happy Birthday!

Family and friends can send snapshots to decorate the box and fill the inside!

## What you'll need

- Photo storage box
- Photos
- 2 yards 1/2" wide grosgrain ribbon
- 2 large dome buttons
- Brads
- Velcro dots
- Glue gun & an acid-free glue stick
- Scissors
- Decorative papers, stickers and other scrapbooking embellishments
- Clothes pins

## What to do

- 1 Start with a photo storage box. To hinge the lid, cut along its corners, at either end of one long side. Hot glue the lid edge to the box bottom so the lid lifts back but not off.
- 2 For straps, wrap a yard of 1/2" wide grosgrain ribbon around each side of the box, beginning inside the front, continuing under the bottom, over the back and lid, and ending with a 2" loop for closures. Glue in place everywhere but along the top of lid. Sew large, dome buttons on the loops, and glue Velcro dots behind the buttons and to the box to correspond.
- 3 For a handle, glue two 7" pieces of ribbon together; let dry. Glue ends to the front of box, clamping with clothespins until glue dries. If desired, apply decorative brads referring to manufacturer's directions.
- 4 Trim photos. "Frame" them with decorative papers in assorted colors, using acid-free glue stick. Hand-write or use your computer to print clever sayings on other colored papers, then cut out. Arrange elements, including stickers and scrapbooking embellishments, all over box and adhere with glue stick.
