

Photo Cookbook of Cherished Family Recipes

With photos of family chefs, a photo cookbook will bring grins and great meals!

What you'll need

- Photos of family members
- Recipes from family members
- Loose-leaf binder
- 1/2 yard fabric
- 1 yard fusible web
- Card or cover-stock paper in various colors, 8 1/2" x 11"
- Rubber or household cement for gluing
- Scissors, iron, hole punch, markers

Optional: Coordinating fabric and fusible web for inside covers; long, metal scrapbooking frame; scraps of thin grosgrain ribbon; kitchen utensils and scanner; stickers; decorative-edged scissors

What to do

- 1 Trim photos of family members to minimize background areas.
- 2 To cover binder with fabric, iron fusible web to wrong side of fabric following web manufacturer's instructions. Open binder and lay on fabric. Trim fabric so it is about 2" larger all around. Peel off paper backing from fusible web, position the fabric over the binder and iron to fuse, wrapping extra fabric to the inside cover. Optional: Fuse coordinating fabric to the inside covers in the same way.
- 3 Decorate the cover with great photos. Use heavy-stock paper to create a double mat and write a title for the cookbook. If you wish, trim corners of matted photo with grosgrain ribbon, or insert title into a metal scrapbooking frame. Glue on front cover.
- 4 Punch holes in heavy-stock paper for the pages. Glue a photo and recipe on each page.
- 5 Print the pattern for a chef hat onto photo paper and reduce or enlarge as needed. Cut out and glue one on each person's head.

What to do (cont.)

- 6 Embellish as you wish:
 - Lay a few kitchen utensils on a flat bed printer and scan. Reduce size as needed, print onto photo paper, and glue in place.
 - Add stickers—stars, hearts, fruits, veggies, and more.
 - Write favorite sayings from each contributor.
 - Cut scraps of paper with a decorative edged scissors and glue along photos.

Voila! You have a gift that will be savored forever!
