

Fun with Photo Paper Dolls

A great opportunity to play dress-up at a party or on a quiet afternoon at home.



What you'll need

- Digital camera
- 8"x 10" photos of each child
- Scraps of colored papers and fabrics
- Glitter paint
- Assorted trims: star sequins, thin ribbons, lace trim, ribbon roses, beads, feathers, etc.
- Sobo glue
- Small, sharp scissors
- Pencil
- Plain paper
- Toothpicks

What to do

- 1 Have each child pose in her bathing suit, leotard, or summer PJs, and take a portrait picture (vertical orientation), so the full body fills the length of the frame. Print 8"x 10" copies of the pictures.
- 2 Carefully cut out the full body to provide the paper doll.
- 3 To make patterns for clothing and accessories, place paper doll on plain paper, and trace around. Lightly sketch clothing and accessories on top of this outline. When satisfied with designs, darken the lines, and cut along outlines for each separate article.
- 4 Place each pattern on desired fabric or colored paper. Trace around and cut out. Glue to paper doll.
- 5 Embellish clothing and accessories as desired, with glitter paint, ribbon, lace, ribbon roses, star sequins, beads and feathers. Apply glue to small areas with a toothpick.

You now have fun personalized paper dolls that kids can play with or you can give to family and friends!
