

# A Photo Family Tree Welcomes Everyone

*All members of the family will love to be remembered in this special way.*

## What you'll need

- 4" x 6" family photos—the more the merrier!
- Decorative papers in various bright colors and small prints
- Pencil, ruler, and scissors
- Spray adhesive or rubber cement
- Several yards of narrow ribbon in a bright, coordinating color
- Large, potted tree such as Norfolk Island Pine
- Large picnic basket

*Optional: sphagnum moss, hanging foliage, bandanna*

## What to do

- 1 For "frames," cut decorative papers into rectangles, 3 1/2" x 10". Cut 6" strands of ribbon and fold in half. Apply spray adhesive or rubber cement to the back of each rectangle and fold it crosswise in half, inserting the folded end of ribbon at the center of the short edges.
- 2 Crop photos to a square or rectangle no more than 3" x 4 1/2". Using rubber cement, glue them to one or both sides of the "frames."
- 3 Tie photo frames to the branches of the tree. If desired, insert potted tree into a decorative container or basket, add moss or plants as a ground cover or drape over the edges. Tie on a bandanna or wrap with wide ribbon looped into a bow.

*Family gatherings are more special when you have a photo tree that celebrates each family member.*
