

# Fun with Photo Jigsaw Puzzles

Turn any picture into a puzzle that will delight kids of any age!

## What you'll need

- Multiple copies of your favorite photo, printed 8" x 10"; one for each participant or addressee, plus one that stays intact as a guide
- Scissors or rotary cutting supplies: 45mm rotary cutter, cutting mat, clear acrylic ruler

*Optional: Felt-tip marker or computer and printer; foam core board and spray adhesive; envelopes or plastic bags*

## What to do

- 1 Use scissors to cut up photos, working on two at a time. If you prefer a planned pattern to random-size or shaped puzzle pieces, pencil lines first on the back.
- 2 For precision and speed, use a rotary cutter. Stack two or three photos on a cutting mat. Slice curves randomly, in one or more directions. To measure and cut straight lines, cut along a clear acrylic ruler.
- 3 Tailor each puzzle to the user! With very young children, back the photo with foam core board and cut just a few, large pieces. Give more capable gamers a real challenge. In any case, leave one photo uncut for a guide, and place pieces of each puzzle into a separate envelope or clear plastic bag.

Hint: If you are creating a puzzle invitation, hand-write or print out party information on the back of the photos before cutting them into pieces.
