

Pictures Create a Decorative Border

Pictures create a unique accent in your home when you make picture borders.

What you'll need

- 4"x 6" photos
- Molding
- Stain, finish or paint
- Drill
- Finishing nails
- Wood putty
- Rubber cement

Optional: Peel-off stickers or rub-on transfers



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What to do

- 1 Measure the wall(s) where you will apply molding. If you are purchasing for a room, add 10 percent to this figure for waste and mistakes. At a lumberyard or home improvement center, select molding that coordinates in style and scale with your existing molding.
- 2 Stain, finish or paint the wood to your satisfaction, and allow the finish to dry thoroughly. Drill a few pilot holes along the molding. Measure 4" below the existing ceiling molding or 4" above chair rail molding, and draw a guideline.
- 3 Using finishing nails approximately 1/2" longer than the thickness of the molding, hammer molding to wall. Counter-sink all nails with a nail set. Use wood putty to cover holes and finish to match.
- 4 Trim vertical photos to 4" squares. Using rubber cement, adhere photos between strips of molding. (Note: Whenever you decide to change the border gallery, you can peel pictures off and rub the rubber cement off the wall.)
- 5 If desired, adhere alphabet stickers to molding.
