

Haunted Halloween Treasure Hunt

Have a spook-tacular time with pictures of the scariest monsters!

What you'll need

- 8" x 10" Halloween or monster photos
- Felt-tip markers or paint pens
- Goodie bags to decorate
- Glue stick
- Scissors
- Foam shapes, Halloween stickers, rubber stamps, markers or crayons

What to do

- 1 Print your favorite Halloween or monster 8" x 10" photos at your local Fujifilm retail photo center, or print at home on 8 1/2" x 11" Fujifilm photo paper.
- 2 Use large felt-tip markers or paint pens in assorted colors to sign photos with clever greetings and signatures. Some ideas:
 - XXX – Frank N. Stein
 - Don't monkey around! – The Big Ape
 - Beast wishes – King Kong
 - I'm keeping my eye on you! – Cyclops
 - Lots of love – Your Mummy
 - Fangs for the Memories – Werewolf or Dracula
- 3 Stash a stack of the same photos in each hiding place.
- 4 Provide each Halloween Hunter with a goodie bag. Or, give out gift bags, and let guests decorate them with Halloween foam shapes and glue stick, Halloween stickers, rubber stamps, markers, and/or crayons.

Hints for a hunt

- Limit the area where kids will be looking.
- Include hidden candies and trinkets such as spider rings and rubber insects.
- Individualize the autographs, so each hunter must find only the photo signed for him or her.
- Give pint-size party guests clues, or tell them when they're "hot" or "cold."
- For older kids, hold the hunt in the dark, and arm kids with flashlights.
- Photograph the winner and print out 8" x 10" portraits, to be autographed and added to everyone's set of photos.

Pictures make every party more fun. Be sure to photograph the hunt while it is happening so you can give pictures to the kids later!
